International Merit Scholarship

Faculty of Law

What you'll receive

You will receive:

- a scholarship to cover 25% of your tuition fees for your first two semesters of study at QUT. This scholarship is based on your entry score.
- an ongoing scholarship to cover 25% of your tuition fees per semester of study at QUT, provided you meet the academic conditions.

How to apply

You don't need to apply separately for this scholarship. If you apply for and are accepted into one of the eligible courses, and you meet the criteria for the scholarship, we will offer you a scholarship as well as a place in the course.

Applying for a double degree with QUT Business School, Creative Industries Faculty, or Science and Engineering Faculty?

You are eligible for our International Merit Scholarship if you are applying for a double degree that combines a law or justice bachelor course with one offered by our business school, creative industries, or science and engineering faculties.





